

# District Land Transfer Criteria

These are the minimum criteria that a district must achieve as prerequisites to Decentraland transferring the LAND tokens to the district.

1. It must have a written Plan:
  - a. The Plan must be published in a way that both the District land contributors and the Decentraland leadership can see it.
    - i. The officially published Plan should be placed as a PDF in the following Google Drive folder:

  - b. The Plan must indicate the basic starting governance structure to be in place when the LAND tokens are transferred.
  - c. The Plan must indicate who all signatories will be to the wallet that will be the recipient of the LAND tokens and which kind of wallet will be used. All keyholders must adhere to and sign the "Agreement Regarding LAND Transfer".
  - d. To the extent that the Plan describes features or functionality in the district, it should be a Minimum Viable Product (sometimes called an "MVP") build. Decentraland reserves the right to request improvements to this document so as to achieve technical feasibility. The current capabilities of Decentraland are documented, implied, or can be determined from the following sources:

  - e. It must have a version number and a clear versioning system so that readers will know which version is being read or referred to or voted on, and what changes have occurred and when.
2. This plan must be approved by a vote of the land contributors to the district
  - a. The vote must be published in the district's channel in rocket chat, as well as in any private chat that the district has created.
  - b. The district leader may may close the voting at the earlier of:
    - i. When 51% of the lands have been voted
    - ii. After the vote has been open for two (2) weeks.
  - c. The plan will be considered approved when at least 67% of the lands that voted approved it.
  - d. This is to be accounted for in proportion to their lands contributed. In other words, 67% of the lands ~~contributed~~ voted, not by headcount
  - e. The evidence of this approval must be in a form that Decentraland can verify, such methods could include
    - i. A Google Form or [TypeForm](#) poll, providing both the form and the resulting spreadsheet and its edit history are readable by Decentraland,
    - ii. A district voting dApp if one has been created but again with Decentraland able
